1. General membership*	<p>Entitled to: Purchase materials from the Guild's Supply room; sell pots during Guild sales according to jurying rules; sit as part of any Guild committee including within the executive; use of slab roller & extruder (if trained); Pottery workshop access at Guild member rates; voice and vote on how the Guild operates and who sits on the Executive; monthly newsletter Note 1. No cubby or storage space is included with General membership. Note 2. This fee will not be prorated.</p>	\$75.00	\$450	\$79.50
2. Studio Membership	<p>Includes the above entitlements of General Membership, PLUS: Full use of studio and all facilities including kilns, glaze room, and storage space. Storage is designated by Studio Coordinator and is limited to 3 boxes of clay within these spaces.</p>	\$300.00	\$18.00	\$318.00
3. Glaze & Kiln Membership	<p>Includes General Membership and storage for glaze materials in kiln room only. Glaze and electric and gas kiln use.</p>	\$160.00	\$9.60	\$169.60
4. Introductory Class Student including 12 week Membership	<p>12 weekly classes of 3 hours each teach the basics of pottery making (wedging, pinching, coiling, slab, throwing, trimming, glazing and firing). Includes the cost of glaze materials and <i>strictly limited</i> kiln firing by the instructor. Includes use of studio outside of class, limited studio storage space as designated by the Studio Coordinator, Guild Newsletter, right to attend Guild meetings, take workshops and to buy from the supply room for the period of time that the applicable course is running. 	purchase their own clay and tools which are available from the KPG Supply Room the night of first class.			
5. Intermediate Class Student plus Membership:	<p>This class is open to all Guild members, runs for 12 weeks, 3 hours per week. Refine your throwing skills and tackle more advanced projects. There is some flexibility in the curriculum and projects may include such things as vessels with lids and thrown knobs, thrown and altered forms, and a teapot. It will include <i>strictly limited</i> firings (2 bisque and 3 glaze) of pieces made during class time only. The curriculum includes glaze making and application, and preliminary instruction on using the kilns. Students will work co-operatively, in and out of class, on making their own glazes with the help, guidance and approval of the teacher.</p> <p>Prerequisites: Those participating must be (or become) Guild members and must be able to center with ease and throw a cylinder, bowl and plate without a lot of struggle. Intermediate students may choose other options such as Studio or Kiln/Glaze membership.</p> <p>Note 1. The fees do not include the cost of clay, tools or glaze materials, or the use of the Guild facilities outside of class time.</p> <p>Note 2.
